XXXI International Draughts "100" Tournament in Memory of Juozas Kulikauskas

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The purpose of the international tournament is to honor the memory of Juozas Kulikauskas, the founder of draughts in Lithuania, and to strengthen the friendship between draughts players from different countries.

2. ORGANIZATION AND MANAGEMENT

The competition is organized and conducted by the Lithuanian Draughts Federation.

3. PLACE AND TIME OF COMPETITIONS

The tournament will be held at Žemaitės St. 21, Vilnius (Vilkpėdė Community Social Service Center).

Dates: October 10–12, 2025.

- October 10, 2025: 13:00 – Opening ceremony, 13:30 – Round 1
- October 12, 2025: ~13:30 – Closing ceremony

4. PARTICIPANTS AND TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

Players from all countries who have applied to participate in a timely manner, registered in accordance with these rules and regulations and paid the participation fee can participate in the tournament, except for Russian and Belarusian players who are not allowed to play.

The deadline to register is October 6, 2025.

All expenses related to the tournament, including accommodation and meals, are to be covered by the participant or their sponsoring organization.

Participation Fee: €10, payable by October 8, 2025, via bank transfer or in cash before the tournament.

5. COMPETITION SYSTEM

The tournament will be played International Draughts (10x10), according to the Swiss system in 7-8 rounds, following FMJD rules. The time control is determined by the panel of referees depending on the number of rounds.

Places are determined based on the following criteria in order of priority:

- 1) Applying the Median Solkoff coefficient system (the sum of the points of the opponents played against, excluding the best and worst results);
- 2) Applying the reduced system of Solkoff coefficients (the worst result from all the opponents' points is rejected, if the sum is the same, the two worst results are rejected, etc.)
- 3) Using the Sonneborn-Berger system of coefficients (summing the points of opponents against whom a win is added and adding 50% of the points of those opponents against whom a draw is played).

6. AWARDS CEREMONY

Awards for 1st place: a cup, medal, diploma and prize for men, women, and youth (born in 2006 and later). Winners of 2nd and 3rd places will be awarded a medal, a diploma and prize. Cash prize: €500 plus the amount collected from entry fees.
