Executive Council meeting - Agenda

Approval of Agenda

The agenda was unanimously approved.

1) Titles:

New titles were approved.

2) Summit of the African Confederation and FMJD leadership in Africa, Morocco, Marrakech 19-20 January 2026. Proposal to the leaders of the Confederations to organize similar meetings in Asia, America and Europe. (Janek).

Janek Maggi, FMJD President, announced that the FMJD is preparing a meeting in Morocco. He emphasized the importance of this. Several members of the FMJD Board will also be present. The FMJD also hopes to organize a similar meeting in Asia, likely in China, in conjunction with the World Youth Championships.

The meeting in Europe will take place next year. The FMJD will indicate when a similar meeting can be organized in America.

3) Appointment of Richard Przewozniak as an "Advisor of FMJD Board",

which will give him the opportunity to support the work of the FMJD in WADA, IMSA and elsewhere.

Carlo Bordini, International Relations Manager, has proposed Richard Przewozniak as an advisor to the FMJD. Carlo has informed the FMJD that Richard is willing to continue his work in the international field with organizations such as WADA, IMSA, and others. To do this work, Richard must hold an official position within the FMJD.

The proposal is approved.

4) Status of the points to be adopted at the GA for e-vote, preparations for the next GA, structural changes and also changes to the statutes. (January)

Jan van Dijk, Secretary General, informed the FMJD Board that the small committee has extensively discussed which topics should be voted on electronically. The FMJD Technical Committee and the FMJD Players' Committee are also asked for advice.

Janek Maggi, the FMJD President, added that the FMJD Board is preparing new proposals and will have more information on this topic in January. Also at the end of February, Janek Maggi will visit the Netherlands, partly as part of the preparations for the 2027 World Championships.

5) Review of financial arrangements and specification of procedural rules (transfers, etc.).

Yana Kuzinets, the Treasurer, gave a short demonstration of how the FMJD financial system works and provided some explanations.

6) International Testing Agency (ITA) proposal for comprehensive anti-doping program AIMS (IOC) – ITA collective Initiative, developed in close cooperation with AIMS and the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).

[Note: ITA for antidoping support, within the framework of AIMS (IOC) with an amount to be provided in the 2026 provisional budget. About 1550 CHF for ITA (really cheap considering that a consultant would have cost us 6k-10k€/year)+ anti-doping tests + treatment of positive cases]

Carlo Bordini informed the FMJD EC that Richard Przewozniak has been working effectively with Wada in collaboration with Renato Capurro, head of the FMJD Medical Commission. The agreement with ITA is part of this process and is supported by AIMS/IOC. ITA is based in Lausanne and will help us to further develop best practices.

Currently, the agreement has not been signed, so it is not certain that we will be able to start on 1 January, as some AIMS federations have not yet confirmed their ITA membership.

This point will be discussed further at the next meeting.

7) IOC criteria and consequent actions, such as:

- TAFISA or FISPT (both IOC recognised) membership about Sport for All (as per point 18, to wait end of January for understanding better);
- creation of a Paralympic FMJD section (concerning activities with people with disabilities,

visually impaired people, etc., already played, as in point 19 of IOC Criteria);
- path to join IPACS - International Partnership against Corruption in Sport (see: IPACS)
that is an IOC body (as in point 32 and transversally in many other points).

Carlo Bordini advised the FMJD Board to wait until January and make a decision after the FISPT Extraordinary General Assembly and Congress, scheduled for January 24-25, 2026, in Civitanova Marche, Italy. He is confident that he will participate and personally meet several key figures in the field.

On the path toward direct recognition of FMJD by the IOC, it is also important to follow the IOC's recommendations and support Olympic and Paralympic activities. Therefore, FMJD should establish its own Paralympic Section. Given that FMJD has already been organizing the World Championships for people with disabilities since 2024, Carlo proposed creating or renaming this Section the FMJD Paralympic Section. The person responsible for this Section will be appointed at a later stage.

Carlo also emphasized the importance of FMJD joining IPACS (International Partnership Against Corruption in Sport), an organization strongly promoted by the IOC as one of its key bodies. The application is free, but requires the adoption of additional good governance policies.

8) FMJD Education Plan 2026-2028

[Note: This was a recommendation from WADA's most recent Corrective Action Plan (CAP), and the previous FMJD Board had committed to presenting it before the end of this year.]

Richard Przewozniak informed the members of the FMJD EC that the Education Plan approved by our CMO, R. Capurro, and WADA provides guidance for the next four years. It is important to adopt this plan and implement its recommendations.

The FMJD has committed to doing so this year. It was decided to proceed in this manner.

9) Organizing the corporate identity of the FMJD (clear and correct logos, etc.).

Janek Maggi and Aare Harak will soon share the FMJD's corporate identity document. 2027 marks the FMJD's 80th anniversary, so we will be celebrating this special occasion. The FMJD's corporate identity is important because it enhances the FMJD's marketing.

10.4. Short Report Players Committee WCup events 2026

Lyublyana Turiy, Tournament Director, has informed the FMJD Board about several issues regarding the 2026 FMJD calendar. Belgium's proposal to host the World Amateur Championship has been postponed to 2027. The FMJD is awaiting the proposal and

details from the World Veterans Championship coordinator, Jan Zioltkowski. China is willing to host the World Championship Rapid. France is willing to host the World Championship National Team. There are several proposals from federations on various continents to organize World Cup tournaments.

For tournaments for which an organizer has not yet been found, the FMJD will send a letter to the federations requesting bids.

Jean Marc Ndjofang, Chairman of the Players' Committee, has informed the FMJD Board that it is crucial to comply with the conditions for the World Cups. The rules and regulations should be known at least 3 months before the tournament, but preferably earlier. The FMJD must also review the details. It is important that the FMJD consults with each organizer so they are aware of the World Cup rules.

Clifton Agata, President of the Pan American Confederation, emphasized that it is crucial for World Cups that the FMJD collaborates with an official national federation. Not every organizer automatically has the right to host a World Cup.

11) World Championships matches 2026

Regarding the women's matches, there's an interesting proposal. The FMJD will inform both women who should play the match about this.

The FMJD is looking for a Dutch organizer to organize the men's matches. Progress has been slow so far.

12) Issue with disqualification of 65 players and all players from the Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan federations

The President's decision is to lift the suspensions of 65 players and all players from the Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan federations, effective January 1st.

The FMJD will develop a suspension policy, as it does not currently have one.

Good communication with federations is also very important.

13) Problem with suspended federations

The FMJD has sent an email to the suspended federations, proposing that they pay their annual FMJD fees so that the suspension can be lifted.

14) Meeting with KNDB 26. February to +1. March in the Netherlands. (WC 2027, FMJD 80, etc).

Next year a meeting with the KNDB will take place in the Netherlands.

15) Updates on the unresolved discussions from the previous meeting:

- Ethics Committee
- Ratings
- Execution of decision of GA 2023 on Proposal # 11

Updates were discussed on the unresolved issues from the previous meeting.

The Ethics Committee has still not submitted the requested full report on all three cases. Therefore, it is not possible to submit it for approval via e-voting.

16) AOB

IOC decision from 11.12.25 regarding youth athletes from Russia and Belarus

Janek Maggi informed the FMJD Board that the IOC made a decision on December 11th regarding Russian and Belarusian youth athletes. The FMJD also received a letter from the Belarusian Draughts Federation. Because this is new, the FMJD has proposed discussing this topic at the next meeting in January. The FMJD's position is not expected to be stronger than that of the IOC.

Other important points on this matter are that not everything is clear yet and that the FMJD must take the time to find out the details.
